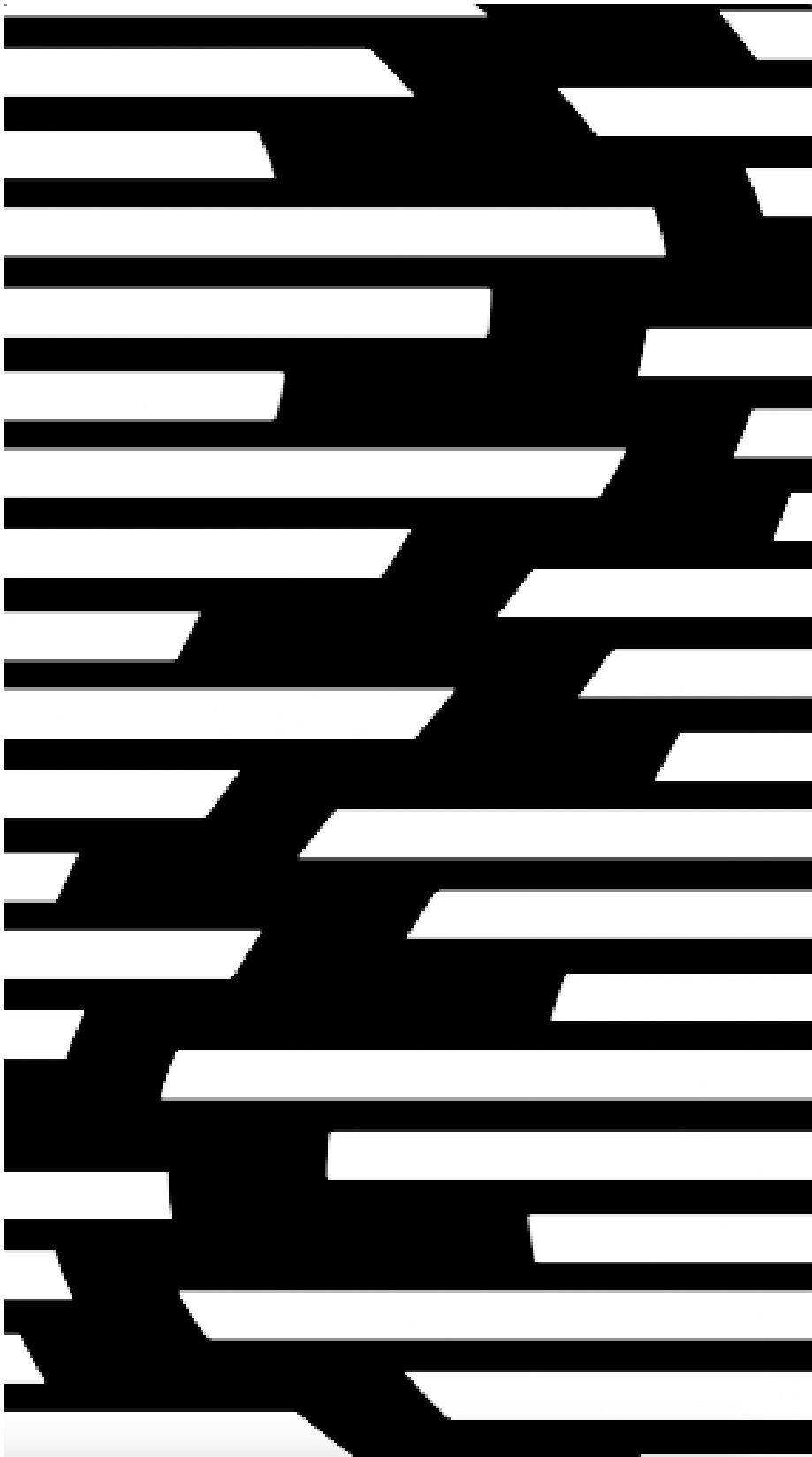

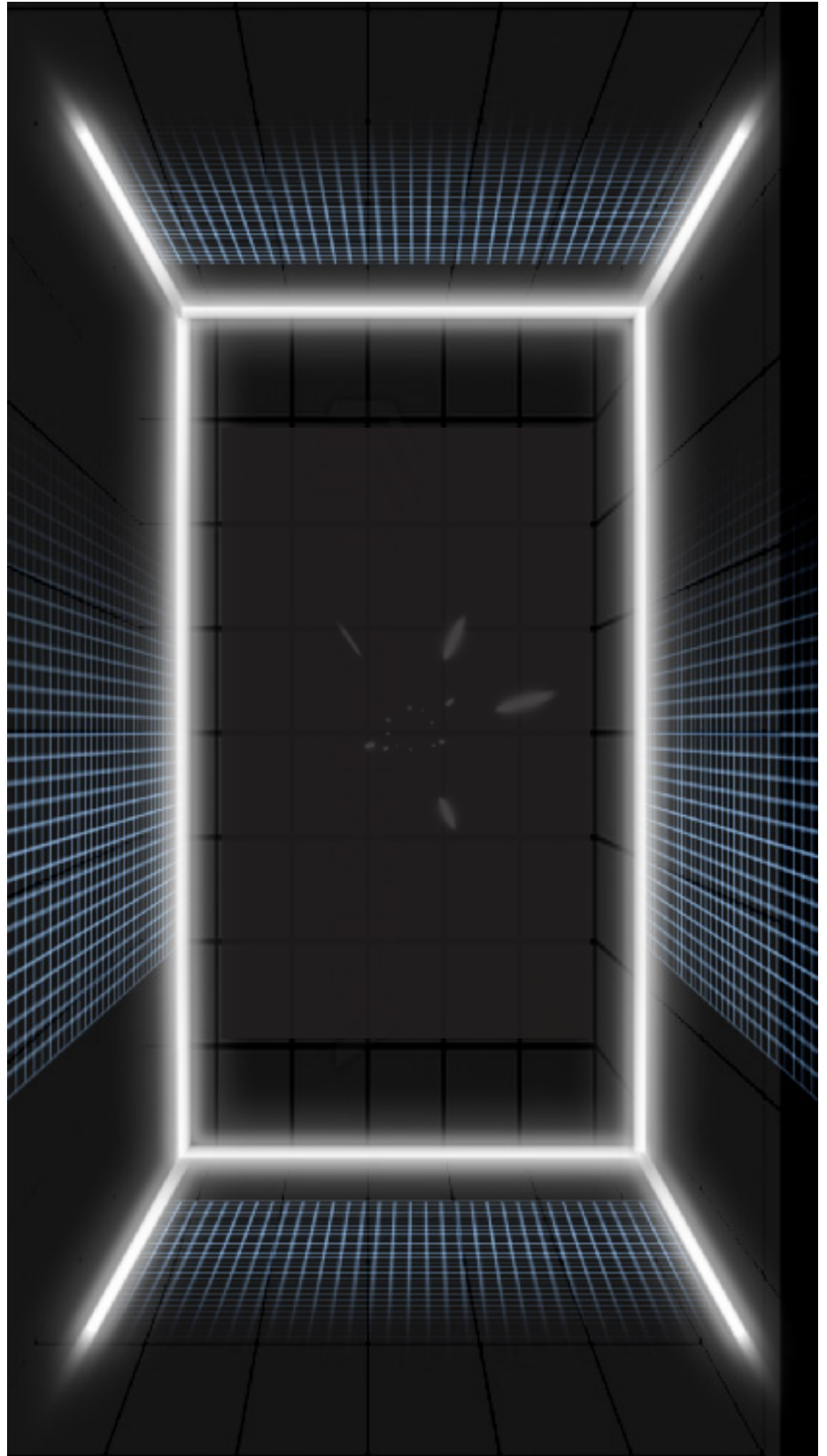
INTRODUCTION

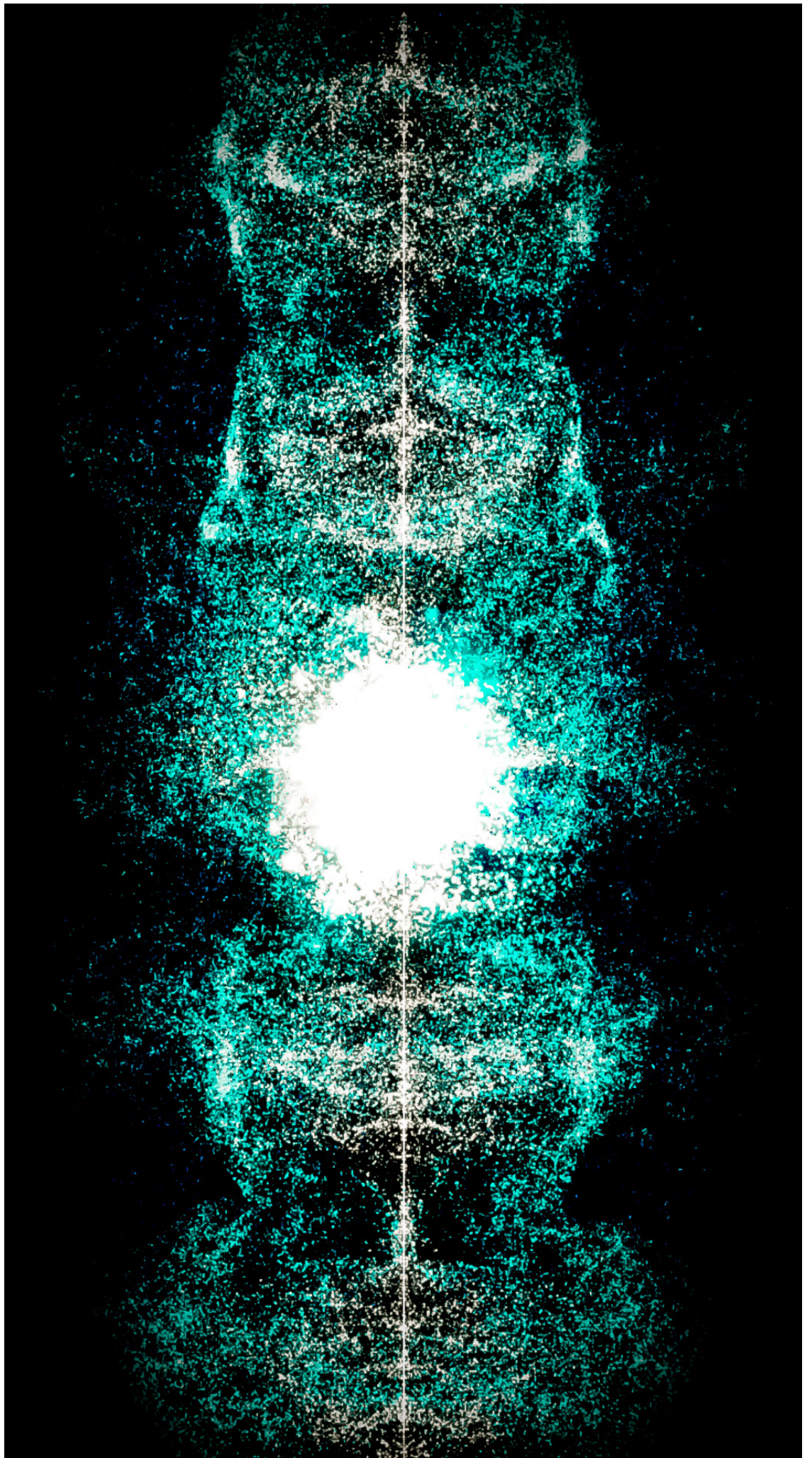
High-rise architectural constructions of large-scale metropolises project their constant intrinsic need of being absolute hegemonic emblems of civilization. Extended injections of computational, media, and technological enhancements push forward the need of architecture to generate structures of hybridity spanning through variable realities, systems, rhizomes. Windows allow us to view the physical exterior from the building's inside. Similarly, matrices of light emitting diodes, as *Hermes Novus*, become messengers of imaginaries, reversing the facade's physicality and morphing the exterior into vortices of visual infinita.

In this course, IMA students developed original content for a media facade. The animated artworks are to be projected on the White Magnolia building, the largest media display on the Bund area, in Shanghai.

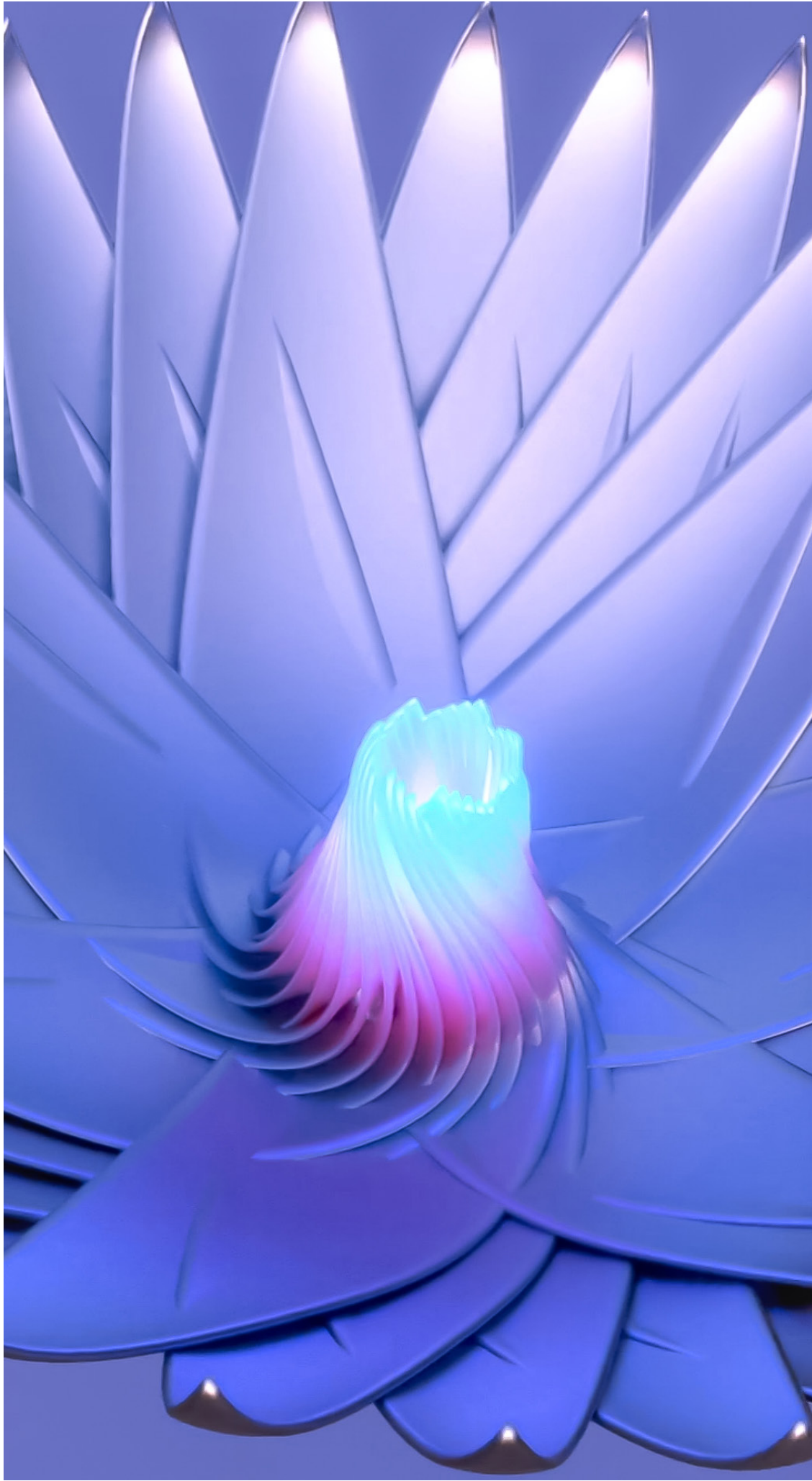


Tearing the norm. Pixels split and spit. Shatter mode. An inwards push.

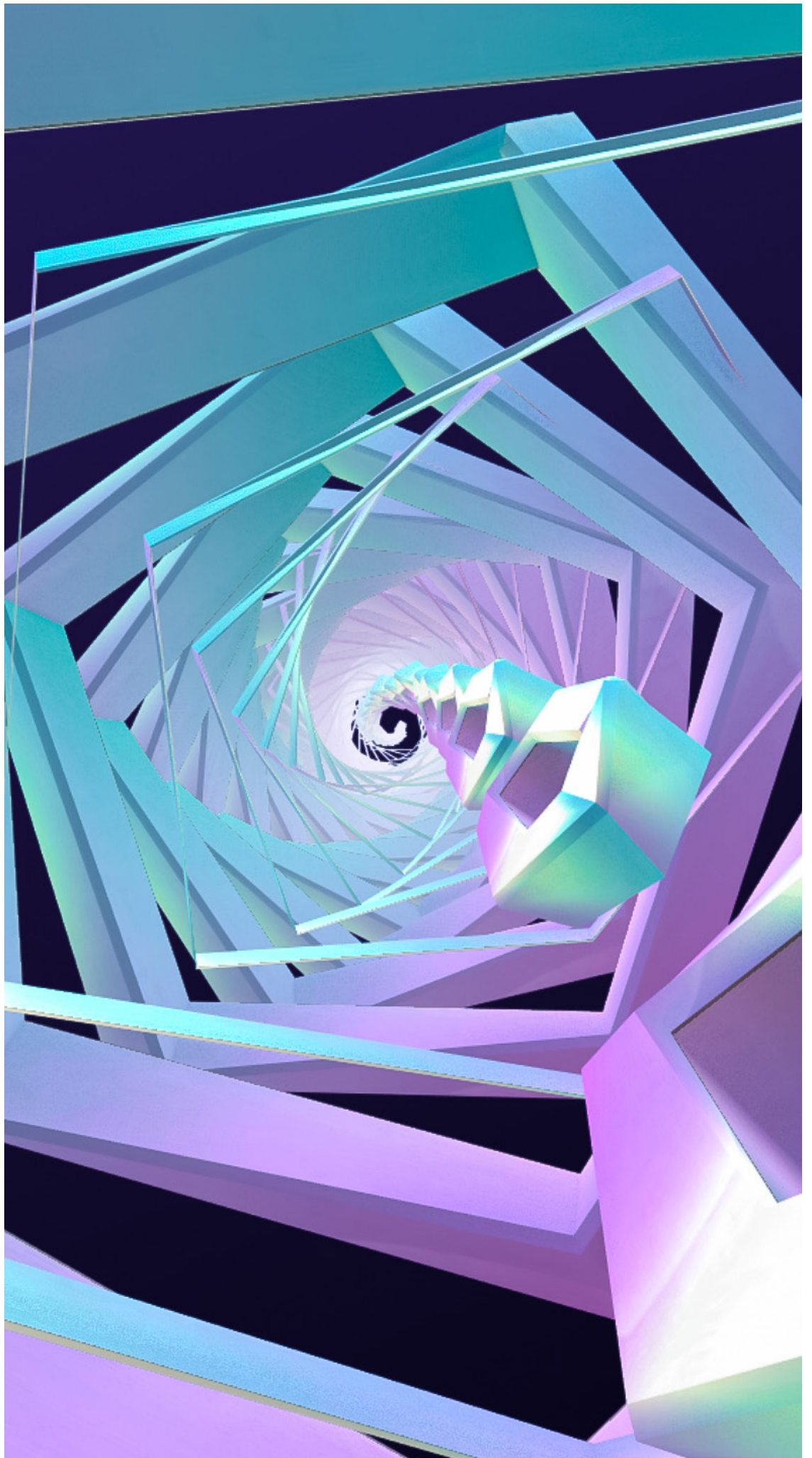


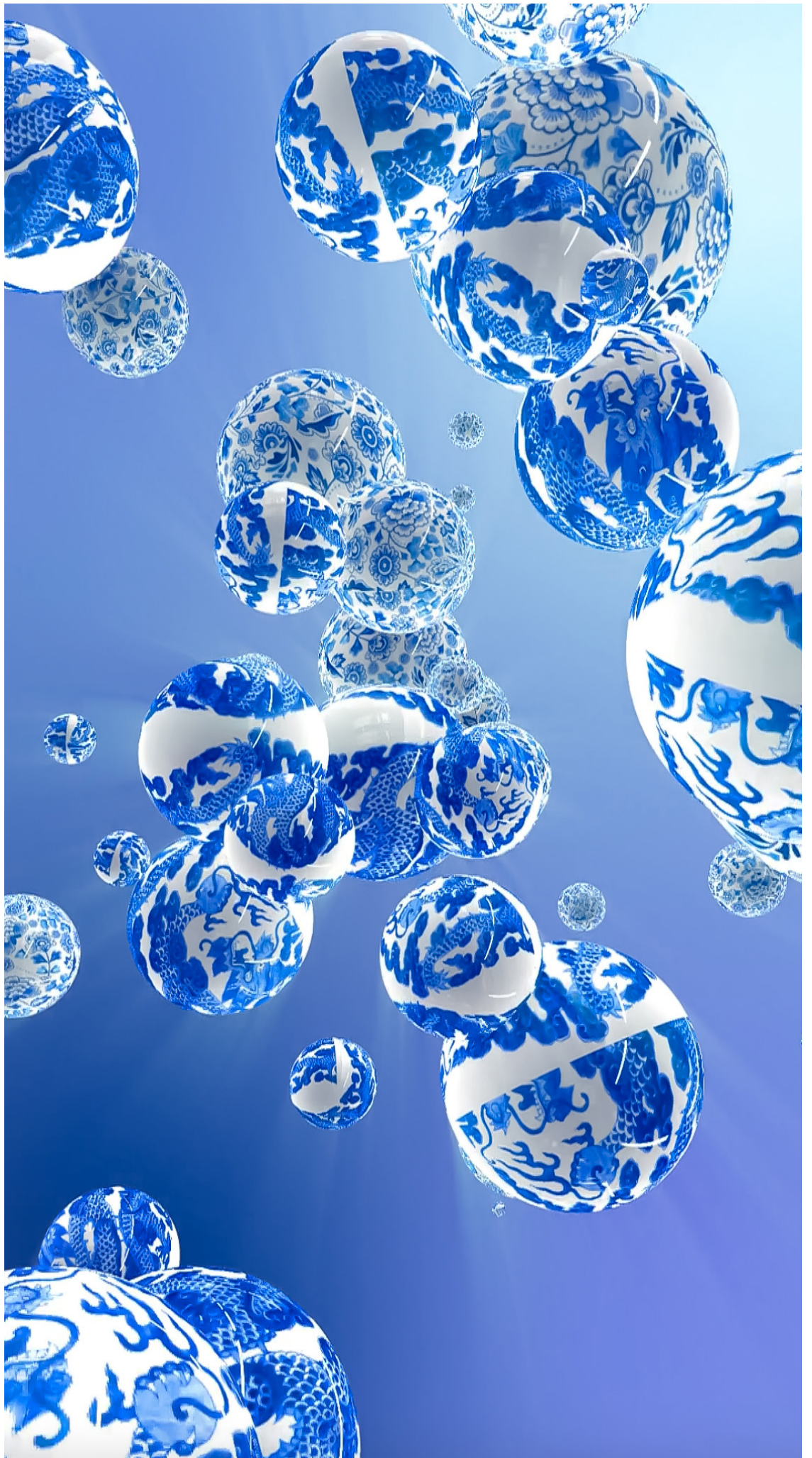


Subatomic collisions. Swarms on entropy, causalities manifested.



Harmonic fusions of patterns and scales. Revealed geometries of adoration and entanglement.

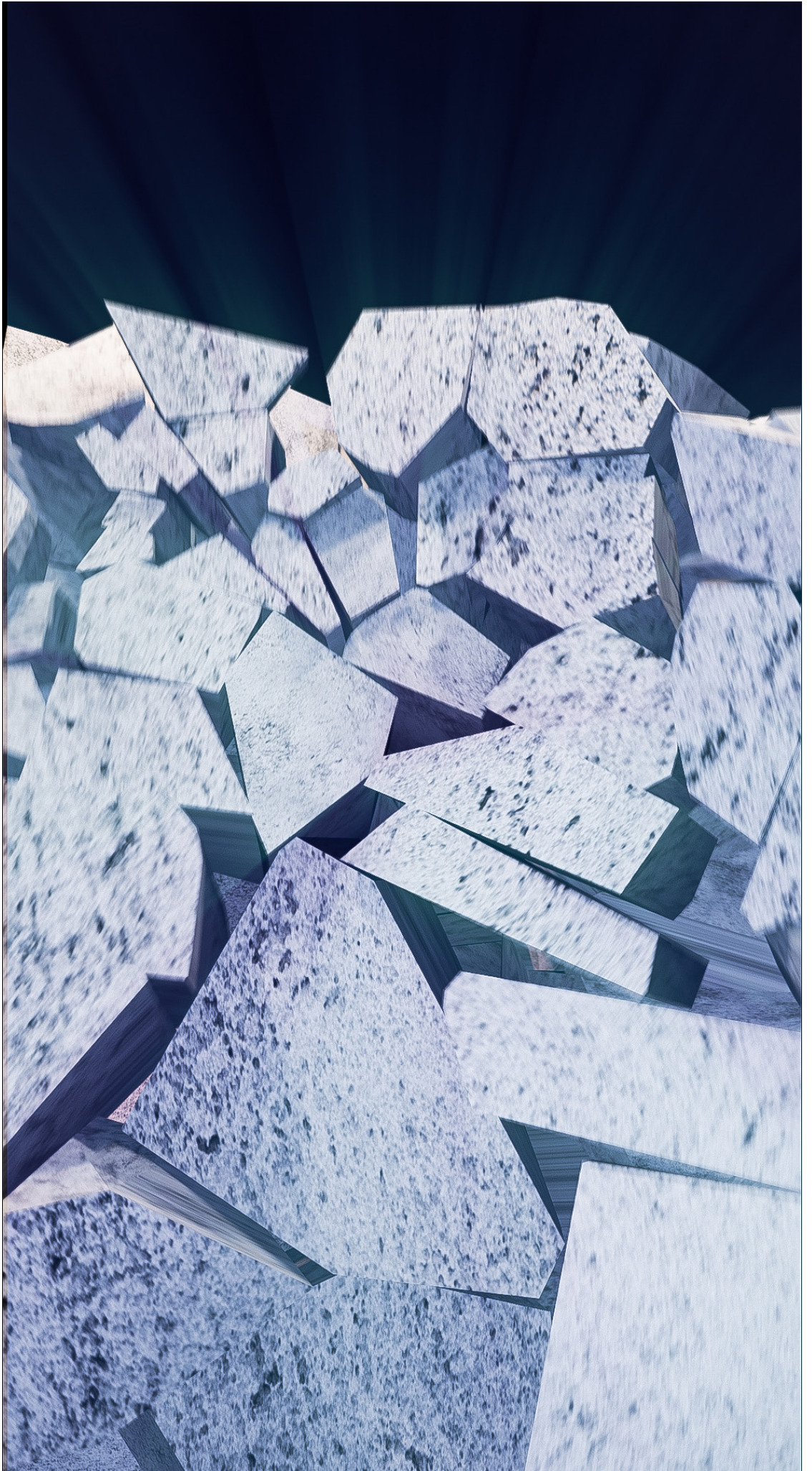




Old stories inspire. We keep what resonates.

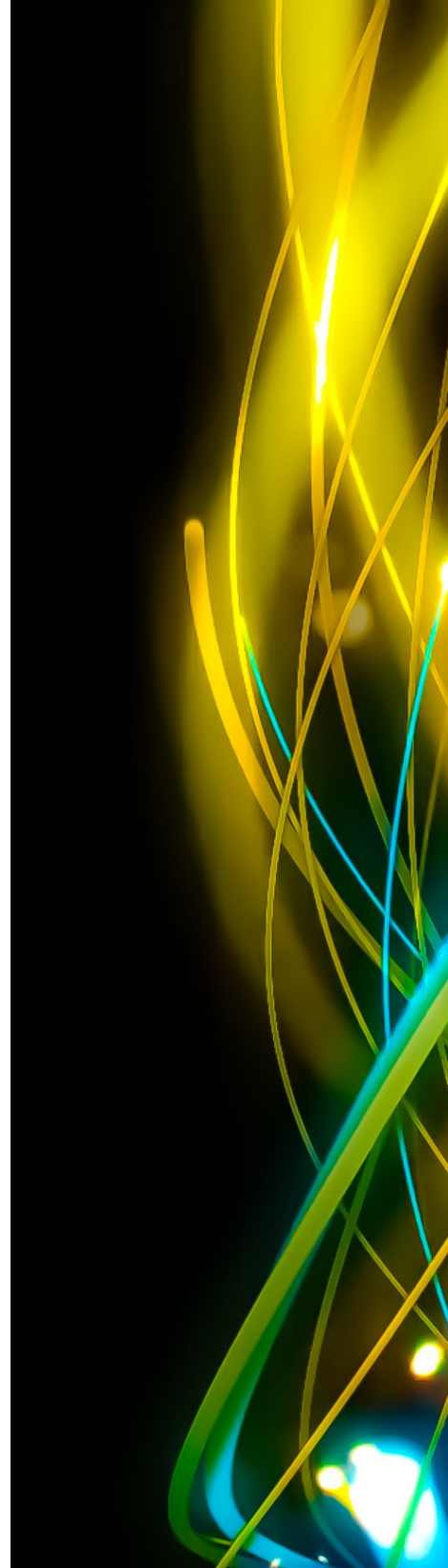
Architectures of ether, textures of poetry; unknowns reframed.

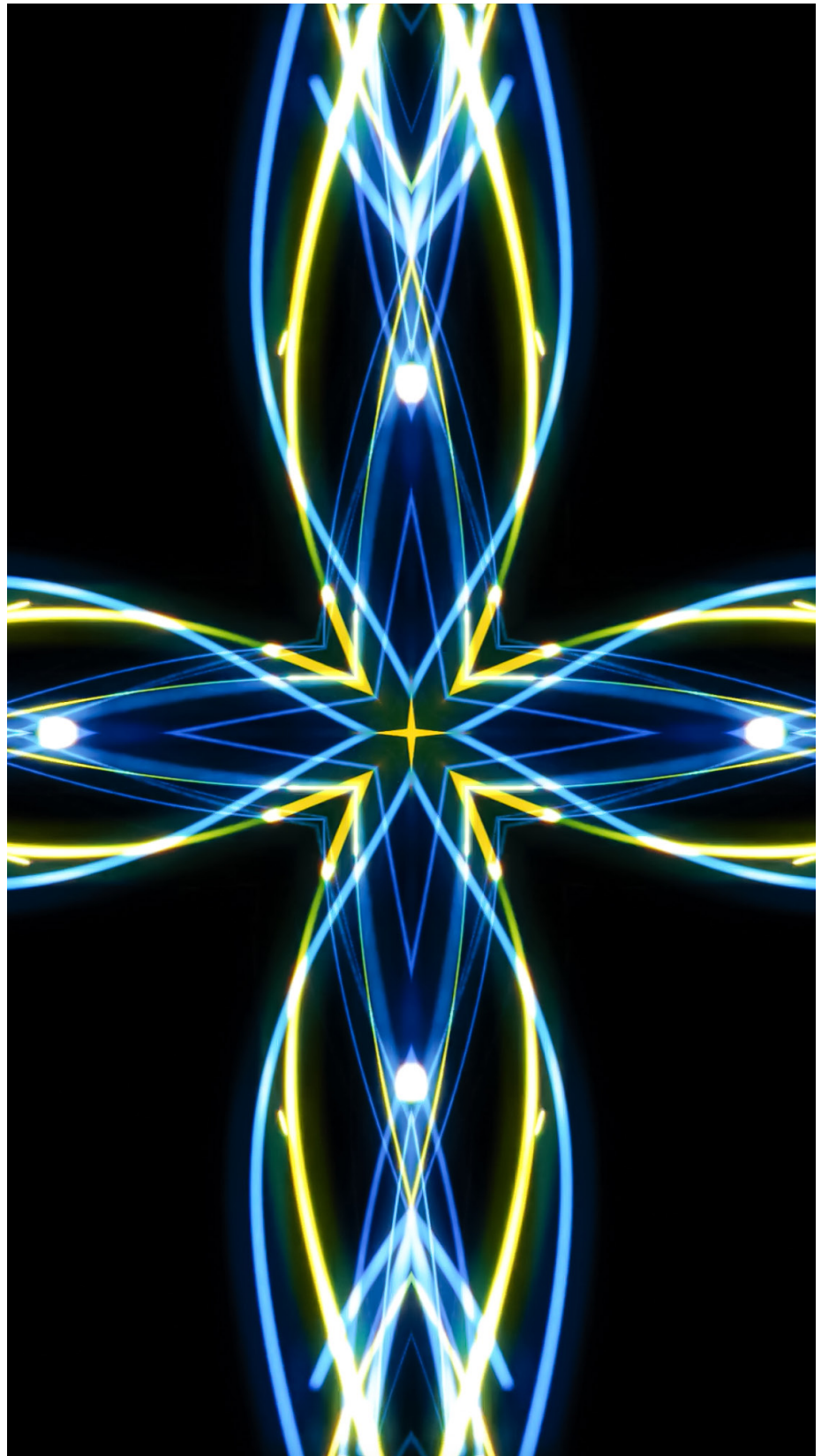
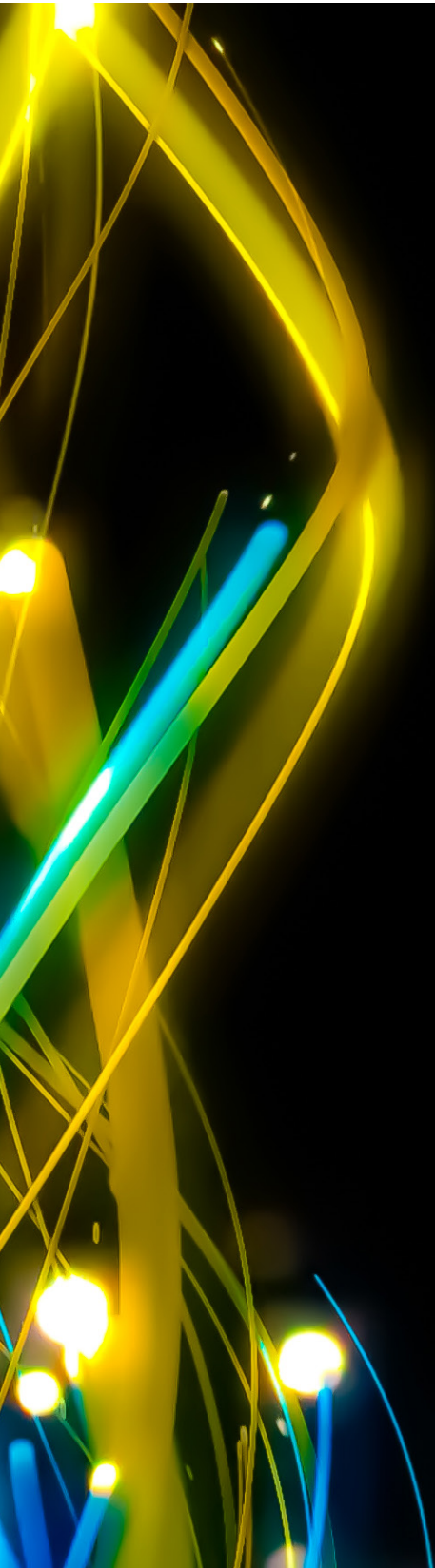




Fractured preconceptions. A facade is rising.

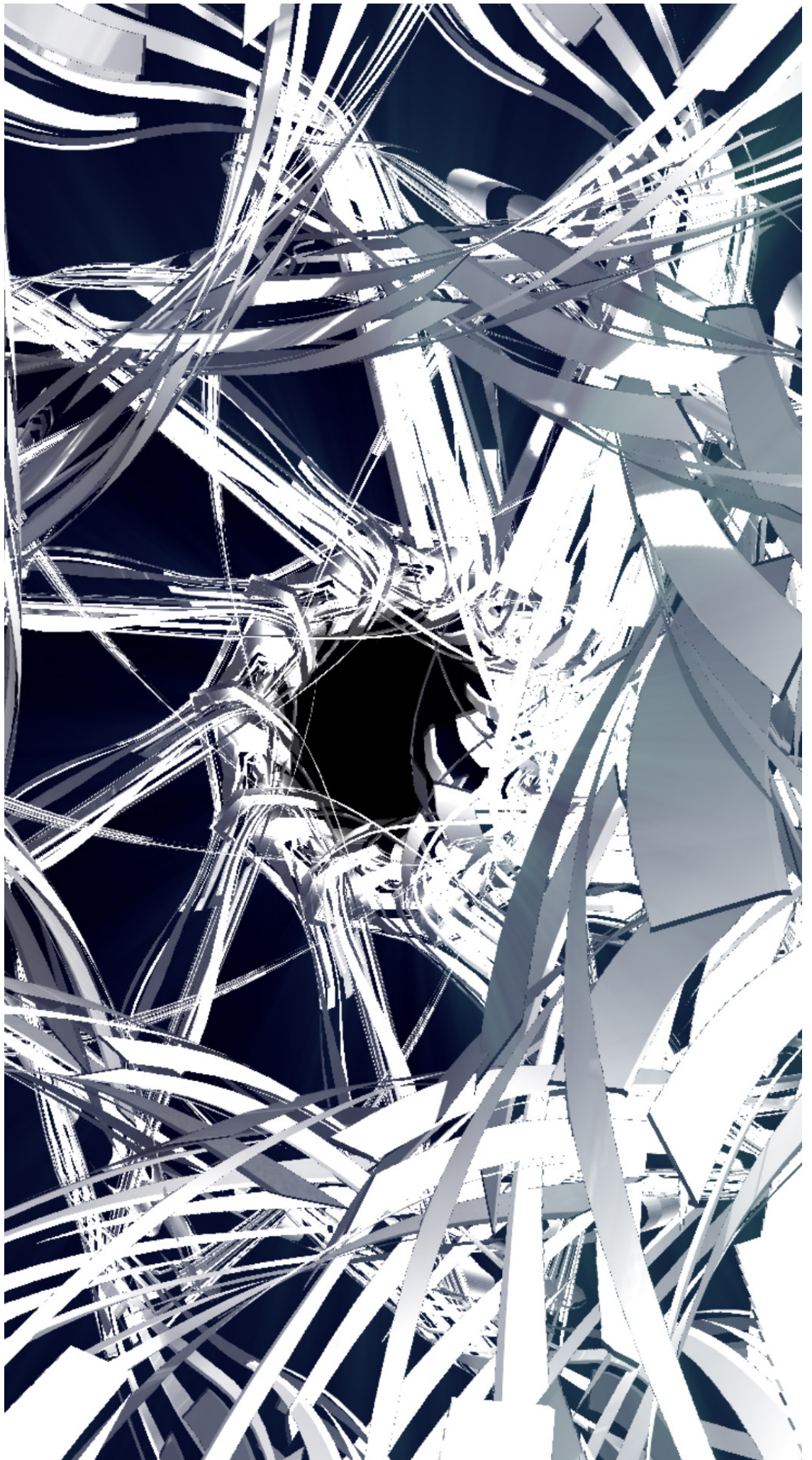
Streams of triggers on metaphysical planes.
